#### **GENERAL DESCRIPTION**

## **ESSENTIAL DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES**

Some of the primary duties include:

- Assist in developing, supervising, and guiding a comprehensive educational and service ministry for Nursery-Preschool aged kids of the church.
- Review and develop curriculum for the Nursery-2's program.
- Partner with the Nursery-Preschool Director to program and run a dynamic large group experience on the weekend.
- Manage the ministry budget for the Nursery-2's program.
- Collaborate with the Kids Team to help create a fun, safe, relevant, and relational ministry environment where kids want to be.
- Enlist, equip, and encourage volunteers for leadership in the Nursery-2's ministry.
- Assist and develop any events or programs for kids and families in the Nursery-2's ministry.
- Develop relationships with Nursery-2's kids and their families.
- Ensure that rooms and facilities reflect a safe, professional, Christian environment.
- Attend staff meetings, retreats, and conferences; keep current in related field.
- Work with the Nursery-Preschool Director to create ideal transitions within the Preschool ministry.
- Cooperate with the Nursery-Preschool Director and Kids Team by performing any other duties when assigned or instructed.

## COMPETENCIES

To perform the job successfully, individual should demonstrate the following:

- **Problem Solving** | identifies and resolves problems in a timely manner; gathers and analyzes information skillfully; develops alternative solutions; works well in group problem solving situations; uses reason even when dealing with emotional topics.
- Interpersonal Skills | Focuses on solving conflict, not blaming; maintains confidentiality; listens to others without interrupting; keeps emotions under control; remains open to others' ideas and tries new things.



- **Teamwork** | Balances team and individual responsibilities; exhibits objectively and openness to others' views; gives and welcomes feedback; contributes to building a positive team spirit; puts success of team above own interests; able to build morale and group commitments to goals and objectives; supports everyone's efforts to succeed.
- **Judgment** | Displays willingness to make decisions; exhibits sound and accurate judgment; supports and explains reasoning for decisions; includes appropriate people in decision-making process; makes timely decisions.
- **Quality** | Demonstrates accuracy and thoroughness; looks for ways to improve and promote quality; applies feedback to improve performance; monitors own work to ensure quality.

### **REQUIRED CRITICAL SKILLS, TRAINING and EDUCATION**

- High school diploma or GED.
- Previous experience working/serving in Kids or Student Ministries in a large church (min. 2,000).
- Proficient with computers, including: Internet, Email, Microsoft Office.

## PREFERRED SKILLS, TRAINING and EDUCATION

- A bachelor's degree in related field; or equivalent combination of education and experience.
- 3+ years of experience leading in a Kids Ministry in a church of at least 3,000 people.
- Working knowledge of ProPresenter, PCO, and/or Church Community Builder.
