### Today's Throat Punch:

### Galatians 4: 8-12 (NIV)

<sup>8</sup> Formerly, when you did not know God, you were slaves to those who by nature are not gods.

<sup>9</sup> But now that you know God—or rather are known by God—how is it that you are turning back to those weak and miserable forces? Do you wish to be enslaved by them all over again?

<sup>10</sup> You are observing special days and months and seasons and years!

<sup>11</sup> I fear for you, that somehow I have wasted my efforts on you.

<sup>12</sup> I plead with you, brothers and sisters, become like me, for I became like you. You did me no wrong.

Fully embrace grace and wholly reject legalism.

My sin is no match for God's grace.

### Romans 8:3 (NIV)

For what the law was powerless to do because it was weakened by the flesh, God did by sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh to be a sin offering.

### Galatians 4:18 (NIV)
