Big Idea

If you know Jesus personally, you will obey Him daily.

1 John 2:1-6 (NLT)

¹My dear children, I am writing this to you so that you will not sin. But if anyone does sin, we have an advocate who pleads our case before the Father. He is Jesus Christ, the one who is truly righteous. ²He himself is the sacrifice that atones for our sins—and not only our sins but the sins of all the world.

³And we can be sure that we know him if we obey his commandments. ⁴If someone claims, “I know God,” but doesn’t obey God’s commandments, that person is a liar and is not living in the truth. ⁵But those who obey God’s word truly show how completely they love him. That is how we know we are living in him. ⁶Those who say they live in God should live their lives as Jesus did.

God’s grace is power, not permission.

God’s grace will lead you away from sin, not toward it.

Jesus has you covered.

Jesus gave us His name, reputation, perfection. The accuser is right, but the crime has already been punished.

Obedience means you treasure His commands.

Obey = keep/treasure. People who know Jesus personally, treasure his words daily.
